We've had some great results in 2016, working with and with the help of the Mandurah City Council (MCC). We installed our picnic table and we are pleased to report that there are funds set aside in this year's MCC budget to complete the asphalting of 3 of the 4 limestone stretches of the coastal path. We're hopeful that the long remaining stretch from the south lookout to Tim's Thicket will be completed over the course of the next few years also through the MCC budget.

We also carried out a large planting in July, the final remaining bowl at Melros beach and have carried out many runs of brushing onto the sandy areas of the dunes along with a mammoth rubbish collection! We also discussed and agreed change to the fire-break proposal at the end of William St in Melros, and are working to ensure that we get the best results for the proposed works to improve the Tim's Thicket waste and septic facility.

We also became a Not for Profit registered association and elected a full committee, which means we can now apply for grants in our own right.

So we wound up a great year with our Christmas party where we also paid tribute to Malcolm Flett who was the founder of this amazing group of volunteers some 22 years ago and only stood down as chairman earlier this year. His character traits were summed up by our members as endearing, patient, calm, determined, respectful, dignified, dynamic achiever, humble and very, very, energetic! We also thanked Gloria for her patience and fortitude not to mention her continued support for the BCCG right alongside Malcolm. We thank you both for your amazing and tireless work
