To whom it may concern

I write in support of Bouvard Coast Care's campaign to withdraw the licence application to upgrade the liquid waste facility until the Environmental Protection Authority have completed their review, and the necessary environmental approvals have been given.

I understand the City of Mandurah propose to take treated waste water from existing sewerage treatment ponds, and spray over an area which has a large amount of hard waste. My concern is that this water will then soak into the ground potentially leaching contaminants from the waste into the aquifer which provides a source of water to local residents.

I am also concerned with the City's plans to locate this facility in close proximity to environmentally sensitive areas such as; Yalgorup National Park, Lake Clifton, Peel inlet and the ocean.

As a former Environment Adviser to the Premier, I understand the serious implications that this facility can have on the environment and local residents and implore you to close this facility until the EPA's review is complete.

Mandurah and the Peel region are a unique and beautiful environment that I believe need our care and protection which is why I support the current campaign by Bouvard Coast Care Group.
